Correction of varus or valgus of the limb remains a critical element in the treatment of knee arthrosis. Improvements in deformity analysis, surgical technique and implants has yielded improved precision with improved results. A recent study from Europe has shown outcome scores after osteotomy have exceeded those after unicompartmental replacement regardless of age or severity of arthritic disease.
